

## SLIS Course Rotation Proposal – Changes for Summer 2010 to Spring 2012

Changes (in red) that are recommended are based on the following:

- Both 4000 and 4010 are offered each semester on-campus and online (for new students), and second session summer school (for School Library students); however, LSIS 4010 is NOT offered in summer school.
- On-campus core courses must not conflict during week (for MLS and MIS) except 5810 (Research).
- Core MLS courses are offered each semester on-campus and online , and either on-campus or online every summer
- Core MIS courses are offered either on-campus OR online each semester, and every other summer (odd or even) either on-campus or online; except 5610 (projects), 5451 and 5452 (database courses), which are NOT offered in the summers.
- In MIS, 5610 is offered online and on-campus each semester, and 5451 is on-campus in fall but online in spring; whereas, 5452 is opposite: on-campus in spring and online in fall.
- Type of library MLS courses are offered either on-campus or online each semester and may conflict; except 5130 (School Media Admin) is offered both online and on-campus in the fall and 5210 (Law) is offered on demand.
- Resources and Services courses in MLS alternate semesters (online or on-campus) and summers on-campus (odd or even years), except School Library (5505 and 5525), and certain Sciences (5220, 5240 and 5245).
- School Library students need on-campus Saturday and summer classes in (5505) Children and (5525) Adolescent Resources and Services, especially (as well as two sections online when offered online).
- There needs to be consistency between on-campus and online program offerings for School Library.
